Sometimes first aid isn't a bandage, CPR, or calling 911. Sometimes first aid is YOU. A person you know could be experiencing a mental health or substance use problem. Learn an action plan to help. You are more likely to encounter someone in an emotional or mental crisis than someone having a heart attack. Learn how to help a friend, family member, coworker, or neighbor in need. Get trained in Mental Health First Aid!

This is a three week course: August 21, 28, and September 4 from 6:00-8:00. You must attend all three weeks to get certified. Register at the circulation desk!
