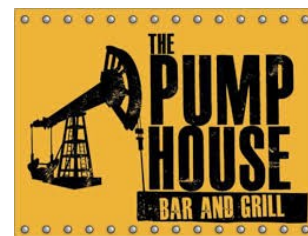

Come by Fridays at 9:30 for a dance party for kids 5 and younger! Bubbles and music are always a great combination!

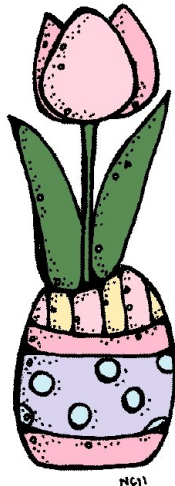
Social Security Workshop
